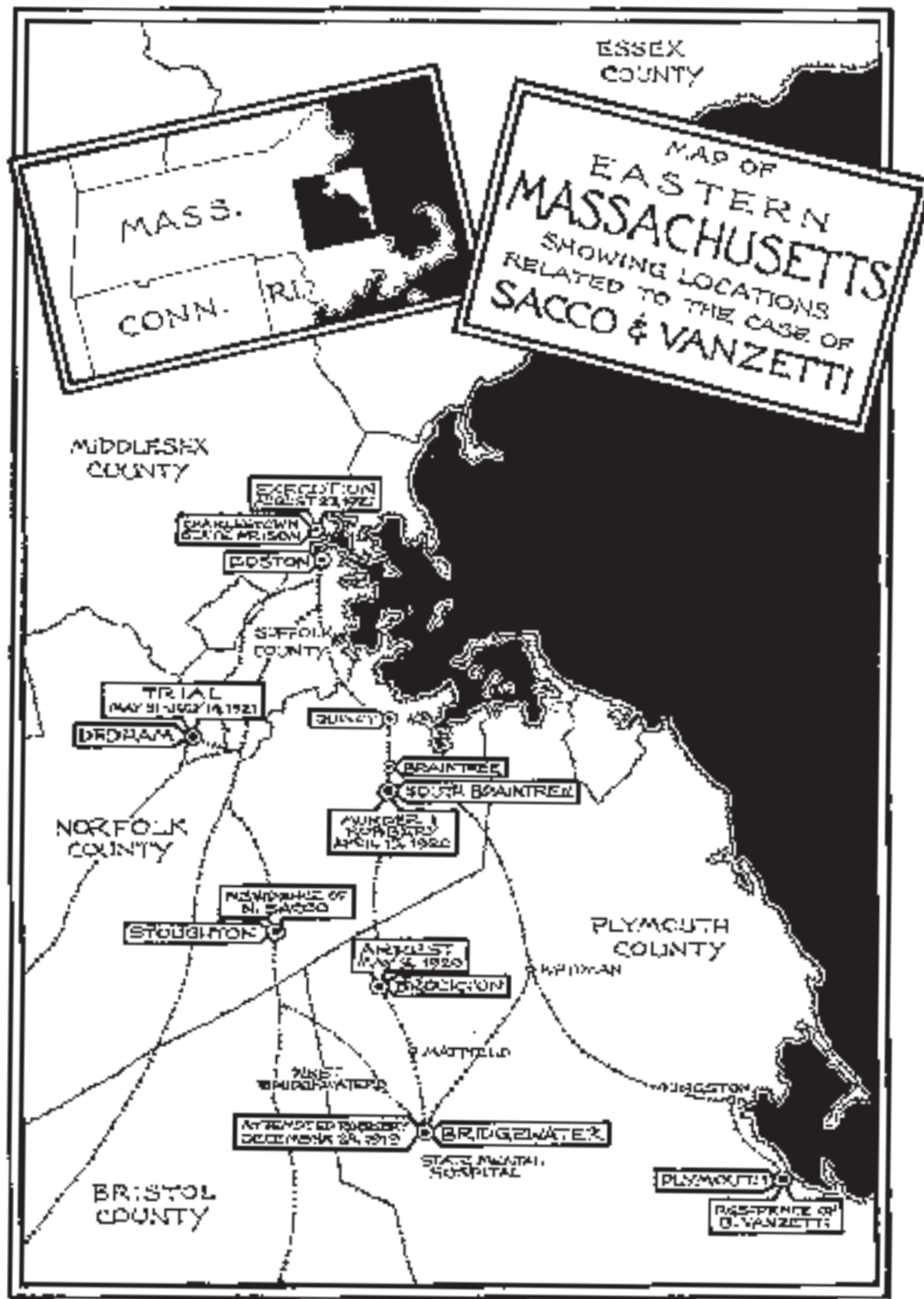

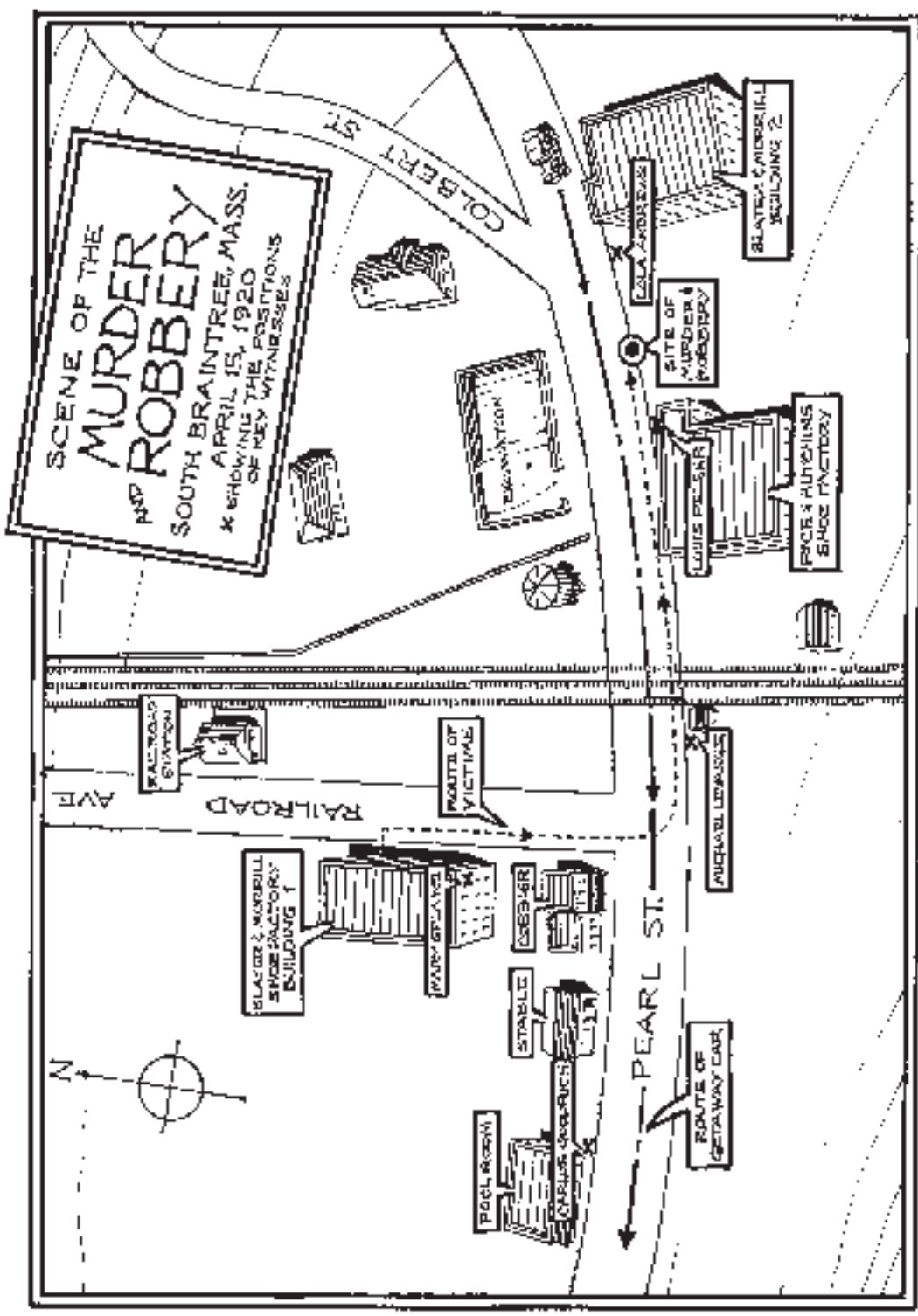

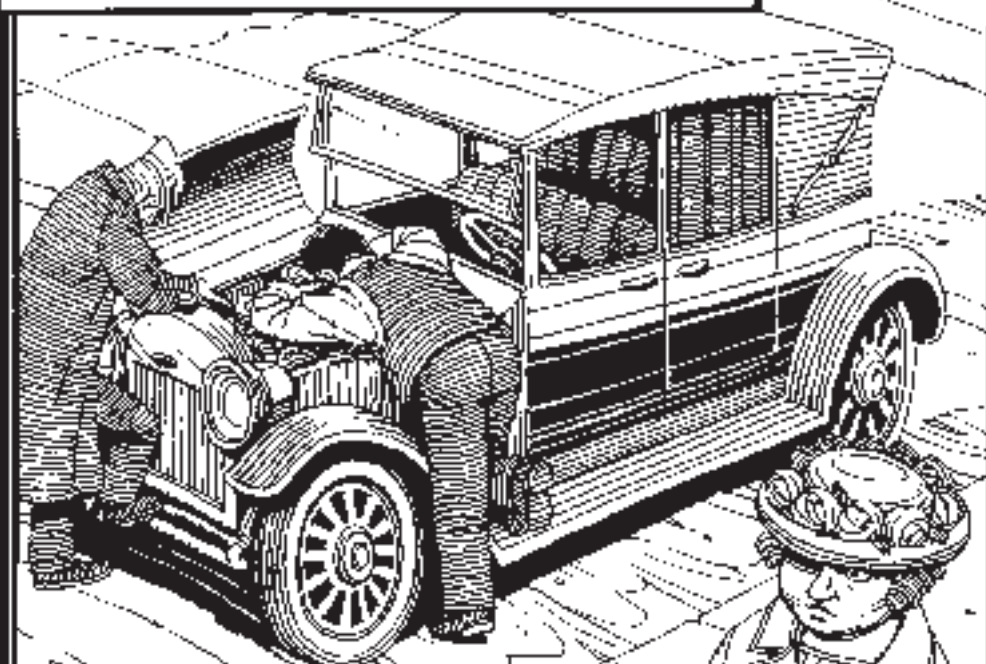
ONE OF THEM IS DARK, FOREIGN-LOOKING.



THE OTHER IS PALE, WITH LIGHT HAIR AND AN UNHEALTHY LOOK.



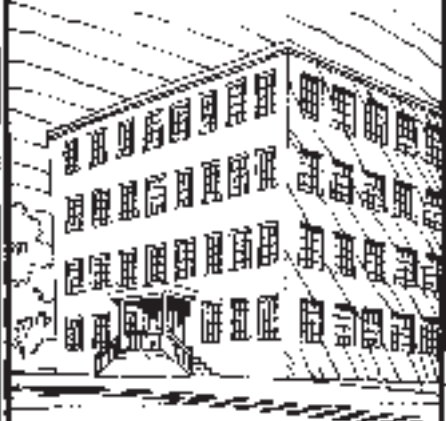

ONE OF THE LARGEST EMPLOYERS IN TOWN IS THE SLATER AND MORRELL SHOE FACTORY.



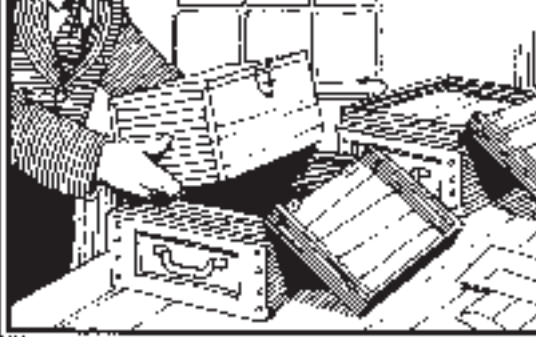
TODAY IS THE DAY WHEN PAY ENVELOPES ARE DISTRIBUTED.

DESPITE RECENT ROBBERIES IN THE AREA THE PAYROLL IS DISBURSED IN CASH.

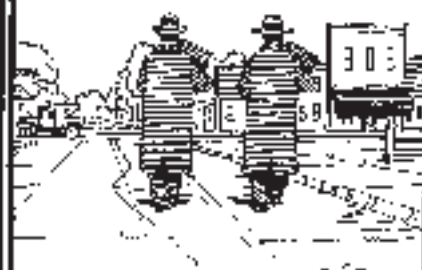

THE LABORERS ON THE EXCAVATION ACROSS THE STREET HAVE AN ESPECIALLY CLEAR VANTAGE POINT.

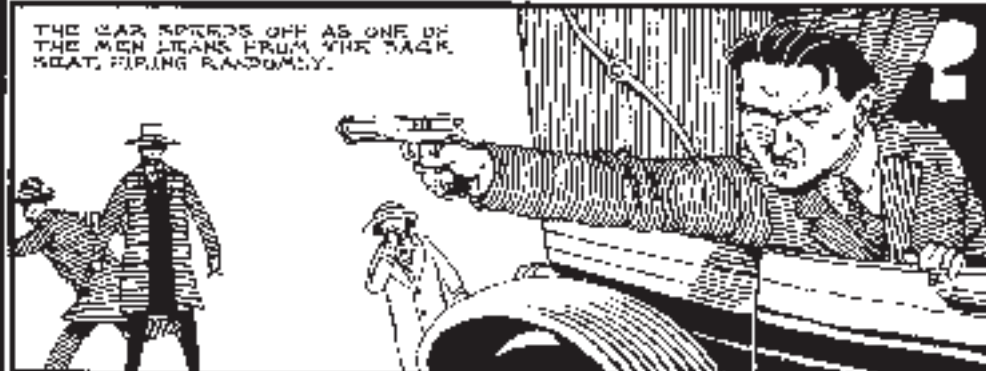


THE DARK BUICK CONTAINING TWO MORE MEN TULLS UP.

SEWARD IS DEAD AT THE SCENE. PARMENTER TAKEN TO A HOSPITAL, DIES THE FOLLOWING DAY LEAVING A WIFE AND TWO SMALL CHILDREN.

SATURDAY, APRIL 17
AN INQUEST IS HELD IN THE TOWN OF QUACY.



26 WITNESSES DESCRIBE THE BANDITS AND THEIR CAR, SINCE THE INCIDENT HAPPENED SO QUICKLY FEW OF THEM CAN OFFER A PRECISE RECOLLECTION.

THE CORONER, DR. GEORGE McGRATH, HAS RECOVERED SIX BULLETS, TWO FROM PARMENTER AND FOUR FROM BERARFILLE.



ALL OF THE BULLETS IN HIS OPINION WERE FIRED FROM THE SAME WEAPON.

THE CONSENSUS AMONG LAW OFFICERS IS THAT THIS CRIME WAS THE WORK OF PROFESSIONAL THIEVES.

THE TRUCK SWERVED INTO A TELEPHONE POLE ATTRACTING SEVERAL ONLOOKERS.



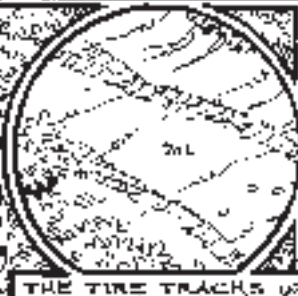
AND THE WOULD-BE ROBBERS FLED IN A HUDSON AUTOMOBILE.

ON APRIL 17, THE NOTORIOUS DARK BUICK IS FOUND IN THE WOODS NEAR BRIDGEWATER, ITS LICENSE PLATE REMOVED.



THE TIRE TRACKS OF ANOTHER CAR ARE FOUND NEARBY.

IT IS THOROUGHLY SEARCHED AND DUSTED FOR FINGERPRINTS, BUT NOTHING USEFUL IS FOUND AND NO REPORT WILL EVER BE FILED.

BY THIS TIME, CHIEF STEWART HAS RECEIVED A REQUEST FROM THE U.S. BUREAU OF IMMIGRATION THAT HE APPREHEND AN ANARCHIST NAMED FERDINANDO COACCI, WHO FAILED TO SHOW UP FOR HIS DEPARTURE ON APRIL 15.

A SHED OUTSIDE, USED FOR A GARAGE, IS FOUND TO BE RIMPY.

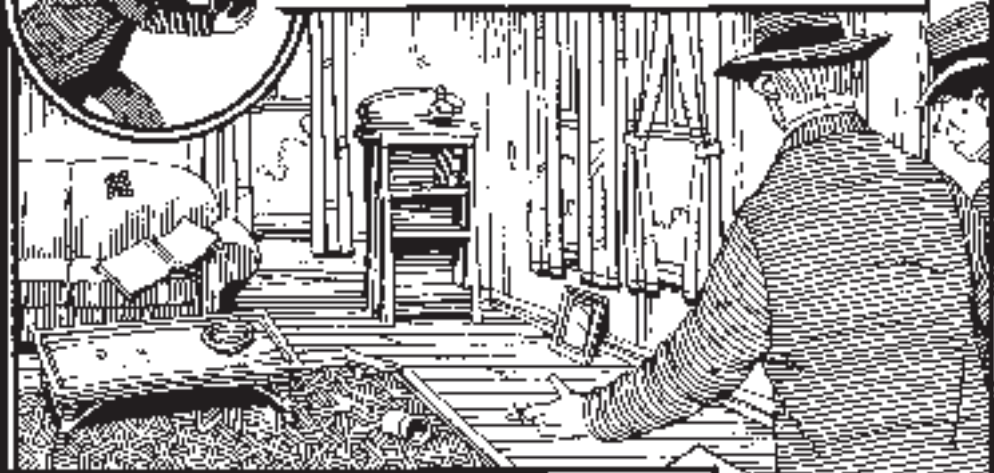


BODA SAYS THAT HIS CAR, A 1934 OVERLAND, IS IN THE SHED FOR REPAIRS.

BARTOLOMIO VANZETTI WAS BORN JUNE 9, 1898, IN THE VILLAGE OF VIGNALETTO IN NORTHERN ITALY.



FROM AN EARLY AGE, HE WORKED AS AN APPRENTICE SAYER AND CASHY-MAKER IN THE TOWNS OF SAVOIR AND TURIN.



AFTER THE DEATH OF HIS MOTHER, HE EMIGRATED TO AMERICA, ARRIVING AT ELLIS ISLAND IN 1908.



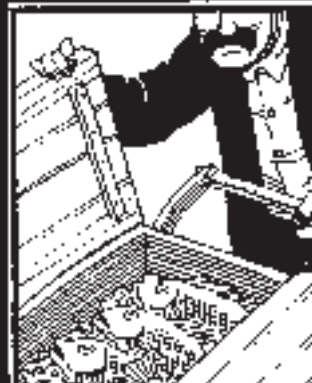
HE RENOUNCED THE CATHOLIC FAITH AND COMMITTED HIMSELF TO SOCIALISM.



VANZETTI EMPARKED UPON A LIFE OF MANUAL LABOR ON THE FARMS, STONE QUARRIES, BRICK YARDS, HIGHWAYS, AND RAILROADS OF NEW ENGLAND.



IN MASSACHUSETTS, HE WORKED AT THE PLYMOUTH CORDAGE CO., WHERE HIS INVOLVEMENT IN A 1916 STRIKE MARKED HIM AS A LABOR AGITATOR.



AT PRESENT HE SELLS FISH FROM HIS HOME, CART ON THE STREETS OF PLYMOUTH.



KNOWN AS A GENTLE AND FORTIC SOUL, HE IS A FAMILIAR AND DELOVED PROSENCE IN THE ITALIAN COMMUNITY.



WITHOUT A WIFE OR ANY CLOSE ATTACHMENTS, HE LIVES ALONE IN A SMALL RENTED ROOM.



NICOLA SACCO WAS BORN APRIL 22, 1891 IN THE SOUTHERN ITALIAN VILLAGE OF TORRECOMAGGIORE.



HE HAD LITTLE FORMAL SCHOOLING BUT GREW UP WITH A LOVE OF NATURE AND THE OUTDOORS.



HIS OLDER BROTHER BASINO WAS A CONSTANT COMPANION. TOGETHER THEY EMIGRATED TO AMERICA, LANDING IN BOSTON IN APRIL OF 1908.



AS HE WORKED AT A SERIES OF FACTORY JOBS, SACCO TURNED HIS SYMPATHIES TO THE SOCIALIST MOVEMENT.



HE AND HIS WIFE ROSA (WHOM HE WED IN 1912) PRESENTED PROGRAMS TO RAISE FUNDS FOR STRIKERS.



WHILE SON DANTE WAS BORN IN 1914,



AT PRESENT HE WORKS AT THE SK SHOE FACTORY IN STURMINGTON IN THE SKILLED POSITION OF EDGE-TRIMMER.



HE AND HIS FAMILY OCCUPY A SMALL HOUSE ON THE PROPERTY OF THE FACTORY'S OWNER MICHAEL KELLEY.



HERE, IN HIS SPARE HOURS, HE TENDS A LARGE FLOWER AND VEGETABLE GARDEN.

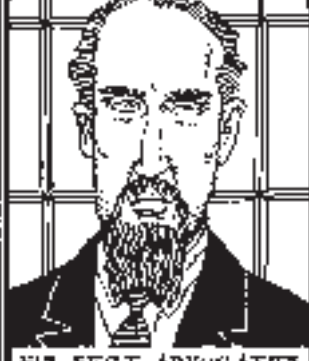

THE WORLD BRITES! SOCIALISM AND WAR!



SHORTLY AFTER THE UNITED STATES ENTERED THE WORLD WAR,

THEIR LEADER, LUIGI GALLIANI, IS A PROPONENT OF DIRECT ACTION.



HIS SECT ADVOCATES BOMBING AND ASSASSINATION AS TOOLS ON THE PEOPLES STRUGGLE.

DESPISE SUCH VIOLENT ELEMENTS, THE ANARCHIST PHILOSOPHY HOLDS THAT HUMANITY CAN LIVE IN FREEDOM AND HARMONY ONLY IF IT IS DIVESTED OF ITS OPPRESSIVE INSTITUTIONS.



IN JUNE SEVERAL OF THE GALLIANISTI EMIGRATE TO MEXICO. SACCO AND VANZETTI AND ABOUT 40 OF THEIR COMPANIES SETTLE IN THE CITY OF MONTERREY IN PREPARATION FOR A RETURN TO ITALY.



THE GROUP ALSO INCLUDES THE BOMB-BUILDERS MARIO BUDA AND CARLO VALDUGGI AND THE WRITER AND EDITOR ANDREA BALSANO.

THEIR PLAN IS TO FOMENT AN UPRISING IN THEIR NATIVE LAND AMONG THE LEADER OF THE RECENT SOCIALIST REVOLUTION IN RUSSIA.



THEIR RESIDENCE IN MEXICO ALLOWS THEM THE FURTHER ADVANTAGE OF AVOIDING CONSCRIPTION IN THE 'REDU MAN'S WAR'

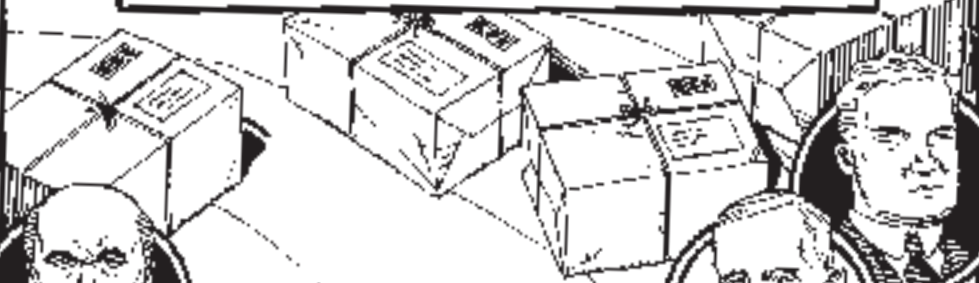
